

Examples of Jasper's past and present commissions: -

Apethorpe Palace, Northamptonshire –to advise on protected trees (TPO) in relation to the restoration of a listed wall, where specialist engineering solutions were required to avoid tree root damage at this Grade I listed heritage site made famous as a one of England's greatest country houses, once owned by Queen Elizabeth I

English Heritage – appointed to inspect well over 30k trees on over 100 separate sites on a rolling schedule (from 2013–2019) across the East Midlands, East Anglia, London and the South East

Forestry Commission – appointed supplier (framework contract) of tree health and disease surveys in Greater London and the South East

House Festival, Marble Hill House, Twickenham, London – project arboriculturist for three years running to supervise the protection of trees at this historic listed property, liaising with the property owners, event organisers and local planning authority

Kenwood House, Hampstead, London – to assess veteran oaks and advise on their safe retention during the continuing restoration work which aims to remain faithful to the 200 year old original design concept of the famous English Landscape gardener Humphrey Repton

Osborne House, Isle of White - to provide expert advice and prepare a tree management plan and work schedule for the restoration of the Durbar Clump, as part of the on-going preservation of the Grade II listed Italiante, Thomas Cubitt-designed landscape at Queen Victoria's holiday villa near East Cowes

Reading Borough Council, Berkshire –survey and investigation into tree-related subsidence cases

Retail development (Aldi, Pure Gym & Greene King), Basingstoke Road, Reading, Berkshire – project arboriculturist from pre-development through to completion with successful sign-off of all reserved matters

St Andrews Church, Sonning, Berkshire – project arboriculturist on planning and development scheme for the new ancillary community building in the church yard. From pre-development survey to formal planning submission (impact assessment and tree protection provision) and on to supervision of tree protection which involved a specially designed temporary access road for construction traffic over legally protected tree roots

Walmer Castle, Kent – to provide expert advice for the restoration of the ancient Holm oak avenue at Henry VIII's defensive coastal fort and home of Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports

Wokingham Borough Council, Berkshire –expert arboricultural planning advice on the Wokingham Town Centre regeneration project at the Carnival leisure complex. From pre-development through to condition discharge
